

If you are getting this letter, you mean a lot to us and we are deeply thankful for your friendship and love. You've probably heard the news that we are moving to the Dominican Republic soon and we just wanted to give you some more information about us and our upcoming family adventure!



WHAT:

- We're being sent from Church at Sandhurst and will be partnering with an organization called The Samaritan Foundation.
- Poverty makes people susceptible to the horror of human trafficking & modern slavery.
- The communities that **SF** builds provide access to shelter, schooling, medical care and spiritual support, giving families a chance to live in safe, supportive environments, making children less vulnerable to abuse and injustice.
- **Skip** will be serving full time in construction, assisting the director of SF and helping on the current building projects (a pediatric hospital, a school and homes for families in need).
- **Tami** will serve part time in women's healthcare.

WHY:

- We want to give our hearts & our lives to work alongside those who are struggling to find a way out of the cycle of poverty.
- We are excited to join the work that God is already doing in Sosua to change lives, both physically and spiritually.
- Skip is a carpenter, wood sculptor & does all things construction.
- Tami is a nurse, midwife, lactation consultant & loves teaching women about health & all things
- Being hands on people with practical skills, we desire to use what God has given us to serve others and show them Jesus' love.

WHEN:

• Our goal is to move by December 2020.

HOW:

- The Samaritan Foundation uses its funds for its building projects and to pay its local staff, providing up to 100 jobs for locals.
- We really respect this approach to boosting the local economy and promoting dignity by providing training and jobs for Dominicans & Haitians, rather than paying foreigners to move there to work.
- We'll be serving in the DR as unpaid volunteer staff, so we'll need to raise money for our monthly living costs (more info on how to support us is on the back).
- It is an incredible honor to partner together with you, as we move our family to the DR.
